### Text:

Aymen is feeling very sick; he is at the hospital to see the doctor:

-**Aymen:** I feel terrible, my body aches, I have a severe headache, I sneeze and cough a lot.

-**The doctor:** Let's have a check up! I see, you have a sore throat and your temperature is very high, too. You have a fever. It looks like you have the flu. Do you have any allergies?

-**Aymen:** I don't think so!

-**The doctor:** Ok, I'm going to prescribe some medications. Please, take these pills twice a day, use the throat spray once in the morning and once before bed! You have to rest well and take some hot infusions; too. You should feel better in a few days!

-**Aymen:** Great, thank you, doctor!
